This process was started in 2009 and has been accelerated over the recent past as BAFA has been successful in its bid to host WAFA during 2014-2017, and we would therefore wish to have things well in place before the start of 2014. BAFA Inc. is now the registered entity.

Secondly, the Barbados Flower Arranging Society in early 2010 approached the Barbados Flower Circle about amalgamating the two clubs. This was accepted and the Flower Circle agreed to dissolve at December 2011. The Flower Arranging Society accepted this same approach.

As a result of these developments it was further agreed that BAFA, having been registered as a not for profit company, BAFA Inc., would instead of having its membership made up of delegates from the two clubs, now accept all the individual members of the two clubs as members of BAFA Inc.

In order to facilitate the legal process of registration, a number of directors had to be appointed as proposers of this new company. BAFA, at meetings of delegates, agreed to the appointment of our first seven members to the board of Directors, and to their positions and their functions/portfolios on the board. These are Maurice Webster, Jackie Ferdinand, Julie Alleyne, Jennifer Weetch, Trevor Inniss, Carol-Anne Brancker and Etwyn Humphrey. The Board

also agreed that each director would be assisted by a small committee in order to facilitate the work of that particular director.

What is important for all of us to note is that we are operating as one Flower Arranging Club, BAFA Inc. We will continue to have our monthly meeting as one club when we will improve and showcase our skills in flower arranging and floral art.

Another activity that we will be undertaking is the hosting of WAFA and the World Flower Show in 2014 - 2017. The Board has already agreed that a Special Committee will be appointed at a date no later than June 30, 2012 in order to facilitate our hosting of this event.

The Memorandum and Articles of Association to manage the affairs of the club, which will replace the constitution under the old arrangement is now to be vetted by an attorney on our behalf to ensure that we cover all our legal obligations and this will be signed by our first set of directors. As soon as this is completed, all members on record will receive a copy.

The Memorandum and Articles of Association will set out particulars about Annual General Meetings, election of Directors, etc., as would have been outlined in our constitutions. We therefore look forward to your support and solicit your assistance as we move forward on this exciting journey toward 2017 and beyond.
